Amino Kamai 7B Digital Set-TopBox and Maxi Linux Remote Control

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Welcome to CŌV TV

COV TV is an entertainment service that gives you at-home access to TV shows, movies and music channels. It enables you to watch live and recorded content.

This guide outlines the various services and features that are available and explains how to personalize your experience so you can start using $C\bar{O}V$ TV in no time.

To use the COV TV services, your Amino Kamai 7B digital settop box must first be connected to the COV TV network, and your Maxi Linux remote control must be paired with your digital set-top box.

Important safety and operating instructions

Read these instructions carefully and keep them for future reference.

Pay particular attention to the warnings in this document.

Amino Kamai 7B digital set-top box



- Always use caution when handling the device.
- Your digital set-top box was designed for indoor use only. Do not set up the decoder outdoors.
- Use only the accessories that are recommended by COV TV.
- Do not install the device in a place where it may be exposed to shock or vibration.
- Do not install the device in a place where it may fall.
- Never place the digital set-top box on upholstered furniture or carpeting.
- To prevent the device from overheating:
 - Do not install the device near a heat source.
 - Always leave at least 10 cm (4 in.) of clearance around the device to allow air to circulate.
 - Ensure that its vents are clear.
- Ensure that the device is never exposed to rain, water or humidity.

Amino Kamai 7B digital set-top box (continued)

- This device was designed to operate at a temperature between 5 °C and 40 °C (between 40 °F and 104 °F). Outside of this temperature range, it may not operate correctly and safely.
- Use only the power supply provided by the manufacturer.
 Using any other power supply may be dangerous and will void the warranty for the device. If the provided power supply is incompatible with your local electrical grid, contact us.
- Protect the power cord from damage.
- Unplug the device from the power supply when it is not used for an extended period or during thunderstorms.
- Unplug the device before cleaning it.
- Clean the device with a dry cloth only.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the device. It does not contain any parts that you can repair yourself.



Maxi Linux remote control

- Do not use rechargeable batteries with your remote control.
- Do not mix different types of batteries (e.g. alkaline, NiZN, NiMH, NiCD and lithium) or new batteries with old batteries.
- If you do not plan to use the remote control for several weeks, remove the batteries to avoid the risk of leaks.
- Immediately remove any damaged batteries.
- Use caution when handling damaged batteries. They can cause burns or other injuries.
- When replacing the batteries, ensure that you dispose of the old batteries responsibly and in accordance with local regulations.

Step 1 Connecting your digital set-top box

Your Amino Kamai 7B digital set-top box must be connected to a TV for you to use it. It can also be connected to an audio/video amplifier or a home theatre system.



WARNING!

Before connecting or disconnecting a cable, turn off all system components (TV, audio/video amplifier, etc.) and disconnect their power supply.

1 Connecting your digital decoder to your television

Your Amigo 7X decoder audio and video settings can be connected to your television in two ways, using the analogical video/audio output (cable not provided) or the HDMI cable for better image and sound quality (recommended connection).



2 Connecting your digital decoder to an audio/video amplifier (optional)

You may also connect your Amigo 7X decoder to an audio/video amplifier or a home theatre system if desired.

With the help of an HDMI cable, connect the Amigo 7X decoder HDMI output with your audio/video amplifier or home theatre system HDMI input (see your audio/ video amplifier or home theatre system user guide for more information).



3 Connecting your digital decoder to a power supply

WARNING!



Use the Amigo 7X decoder only with the power adapter provided. Connect the decoder directly to an electrical outlet or power bar as needed. **Never use an extension cord.**



Step 2 Inserting batteries into the remote control

- 1 Open the battery compartment by pressing on the cover and sliding it downward.
- 2 Insert the batteries by matching the + and symbols on the batteries with those inside the compartment.
- 3 Slide the cover upward until you hear a click.



Step 3

Pairing your remote control with your digital decoder (initial activation)

You must first pair your Amigo 7X digital decoder with your Maxi_V1 remote control.

NOTE Your remote control can be connected to only one digital decoder at a time.

Follow the pairing instructions on your television screen if they appear. Otherwise, follow the instructions in this guide.

Before pairing

- Ensure the digital decoder is on
- Ensure the selected input source matches the digital decoder output (for example, HDMI1)

NOTE To find out how to change your television's input source, consult your user guide.





- 2 The button will flash once to confirm that pairing was successful.
- 3 "Connecting Amigo-Maxi" will appear at the bottom of your television screen once both buttons have been released.



4 "Successfully paired Amino-Maxi" will appear at the bottom of your television screen once connection has been made.



Step 4

Connecting your digital decoder to your Wi-Fi network

Your digital decoder must be connected to your Wi-Fi network before use (see Wi-Fi guide)

NOTE To connect your digital decoder to your Wi-Fi network, it must be in normal operation mode and paired with your remote control. **Our qualified technicians will carry out this step when your Amigo 7X decoder is being set up.**

Connecting your digital decoder to your Wi-Fi network

1 Use the ▲ ▼ arrows on your remote control to select the Wi-Fi Residents network Residents (see the Wi-Fi guide). Press the → button to confirm.



2 Enter your password with the online alphanumeric keypad. Using the remote control arrows, select the password characters that appear in the text box. Use the same procedure to enter each password character. Select and press the button once you have finished entering your password. You may select the "Hide password" box to hide characters.

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Once you have released the , test the volume. The test will appear on your television screen to inform you that Maxi_V1 programming with your television was successful. You can press OK on the "**It's working**" tab at the bottom of your television screen.



4 If the "Unrecognizable device" message appears at the bottom of your screen, press the for to return to your Amigo 7X main menu. Program your Maxi_V1 remote control with your television manually.

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5 Manual programming

.:. To put remote control in infrared mode (IM), press and 3 for at least three seconds. The STB button will flash twice when remote control is in IM mode. If you make a mistake, press STB to abort the procedure; the remote control will return to normal operation. No television brand code will be stored.

- Look for the four-number television brand code on this website:
 https://www.amino.tv/wp-content/uploads/2021/02/tv-brand-code-sets-for-willow-oak-birch-mini-maxi-remote.
- : Ensure your television is on. The STB need not be on while searching for the brand.
- ∴ Press 1 and 3 for at least three seconds until the TV/AUX POWER button flashes twice and stays on.
- : Enter your television brand code. The TV/AUX POWER button will flash when you enter each number.
- .: The STB button will flash once and stay on if successful. If unsuccessful, the TV/AUX POWER button will flash for a long time and the remote control will return to normal operation. No television brand code will be stored.
- .: To ensure the television remote control works, keep pressing the TV/ AUX POWER or MUTE button. Release TV/AUX POWER or MUTE when the television is off or muted.
- ∴ Press Go back for exit the brand search mode.

NOTE The remote control must be reprogrammed if you change television brand. Perform the brand search procedure again with your new television brand code.

TV guide Browsing the guide

Browsing channels

To browse the channel list, use the **A v** arrows on your remote control. Press **ok** to select a channel.

To browse the channel list by moving between pages, use the g button.

To put on a specific channel, enter the channel number using the **0** to **9** buttons on your remote control, then press **OK**.

Navigating the schedule

To move forward or backward in time, use the \blacksquare arrows on your remote control.

When viewing the TV guide for a future date or time, press the **____** button onyour remote control to return to the current date and time.

Use the button to move forward 12 hours.

Use the vertice button to move backward 12 hours.

To return to the content that is currently being shown, press

Using COV TV Information bar

You can display an information bar to see information about the content that you are watching, as well as upcoming content, without interrupting your viewing experience.

To display the information bar, press the **m** button on your remote control while you are watching live content.

To access the Details screen for the selected content, press the visioner shortcut.

Using COV TV Parental controls

The parental controls feature blocks access to certain content based on its category (see the Rating tables on page 82 for the different categories).

NOTE COV TV USES THE US RATING SYSTEM FOR TV SHOWS AND MOVIES.

Content blocked by parental controls is not displayed in the TV guide, in the category rows, in the recommendations or in the search results, and it cannot be watched.

In addition, when parental controls are activated, channels rated Adult by the service provider will not appear in the TV guide or when you browse channels in full screen mode.



Below are steps to turn parental control on and off.

Using the Maxi_V1 remote control, press OK

5 Sets timeline for blocking content (between 30 and 1,440 minutes).

Problem	Cause/Solution
My TV is on, but my remote control is not working.	The remote control is in Standby mode or the batteries are dead.
	 Press the OK button on your remote control, wait 5 seconds and press the GUIDE button.
	 Replace the batteries in the remote control.

Problem	Cause/Solution
My digital set-top box is on, but no picture is showing on the screen.	 Turn on your TV using the remote control for your TV.
	 If that does not work, press the SOURCE/INPUT button on the remote control for the TV and choose the source that corresponds to your digital set-top box.
	 If there is still no picture, check that the HDMI cable is correctly plugged in to your digital set-top box and your TV.
My TV is on, but my digital set-top box is not turning on.	 Ensure that the power cord for the digital set-top box is correctly plugged in to the electrical outlet and that the power button on the back of the digital set-top box is set to the number 1. The light on the power button should be red.
	 Manually turn on the digital set-top box by pressing the button on the front, to the left. The light on the button should turn blue.
	 3. Press the GUIDE button on the remote control for the digital set-top box. If the light on the Operative button on the remote control is not blue, check the batteries and replace them if needed.

Problem	Cause/Solution
A "No Signal" message is showing on my TV screen.	 Press the Over the button on your remote control If that does not work, press Over the again, and then, on the remote control for the TV, press the Input, Video Source or Source button until a picture appears.
A "Video Signal Blocked" message is showing on my TV screen.	You are not subscribed to this channel. To subscribe, call us at 1-833-624-9290.

Problem	Cause/Solution
My TV screen is black and no picture is showing.	 Press the (), button, then the GUDE button to check that you still have access to the TV guide. If nothing appears, turn the TV off and on by pressing the () button and press the () button to check that your TV is on the correct source. If the TV guide appears, try to change the channel. If that still does not work, check that the HDMI cable is correctly plugged in to the TV and the digital set-top box, and that the set-top box is on.
The picture on my TV screen freezes or is pixelated or blurry.	Restart the digital set-top box by unplugging the power cord from the power outlet (wall or power bar), and then wait for the picture to reappear.
Subtitles are showing on the screen and I would like to turn them off.	Press the SUB/CC button on your remote control.
I can no longer access the TV guide, the menu, or the channel information.	Call Technical Support.

Problem	Cause/Solution
I replaced my TV and cannot control it using the remote control for the digital set- top box (turn on the TV, change the volume or change the channel).	The remote control for the digital set-top box is not paired with your new TV. Follow the instructions in the Step 5: Pairing your remote control with your TV (optional) section on page 28.
I replaced my digital set-top box and cannot pair it with my Maxi Linux remote control.	 Before pairing your new set-top box with your remote control, you must reset your remote control to restore its original settings: 1. Press the 1 and 6 buttons on your remote control simultaneously until the button flashes, and then stays illumniated. 2. Next, enter 981 using the buttons on your remote control. The button flashes and the original remote-control settings are restored. You can then pair the remote control with your new digital set-top box by following the Step 3: Pairing your remote control with your digital set-top box (initial activation) procedure on page 18.
